

To be considered for admission with advanced standing, you must:





Provide all transcripts from prior medical school(s), and undergraduate and graduate programs

Submit two letters of recommendation

Supply MCAT results (if applicable)

Pay the application fee

Note: You may also be required to submit a dean's letter and other documents from previous medical schools.
